## WhiteRose Preschool Contract Acknowledgment, Assumption of Risk and Release

I, the undersigned, agree to commit to the full school tuition for the school year starting September 2011 and ending June 2012. I understand that I am responsible for 10 monthly payments of \$\_\_\_\_\_, beginning August 1st, 2011 with the final payment on May 1st, 2012, and with a Materials & Equipment fee of \$\_\_\_\_\_, due upon acceptance for new families and February 15th for returning families. A \$50 Interview Fee, paid at initial interview, will be deducted from the Materials & Equipment Fee upon signing of Contract.

My child's schedule will be:

MWF  or TT  or M-F

Drop off is at 8:30am. Pick up is at 3:20pm.

At White Rose, we follow Shining Mountain Waldorf School's holiday schedule. A full holiday and events schedule is available on our website. Our snow days policy follows Boulder Valley School District's closure schedule.

Tuition is billed and paid **one month** in advance. As a courtesy, one week prior to the first day of each month a sign will be posted on the entrance to White Rose Preschool to remind you that tuition is due, and that payment is due no later than the 5th of the month. Late tuition will be subject to a \$25.00 late fee. Tuition due reminders will also be posted on the White Rose Blog as well as marked on the White Rose Calendar, both of which can be found on our website.

Please remember Material & Equipment Fees are non refundable.

I understand that the full monthly fee is due even in cases of absence due to illness or travel and that children may not switch days. If space permits, parents may add an extra day for a charge of \$70. Please check with Miss Cheryl to determine if there is available space on a certain day.

If late tuition is not paid by the end of the month, my child may not attend school until the balance and a late fee is paid in full. I hereby acknowledge and agree that any account that becomes delinquent will be subject to collections service. A \$30.00 service charge fee will be paid on all returned checks.

For new admissions, either party has the right to terminate this contract within the first 14 days of signing such contract. However, Equipment & Materials Fees, payable upon signing of contract, and/or the initial Interview Fee, are non-refundable.

Parents are obligated, on a rotating basis, to provide weekly Snack for the whole group. See the FAQ section on the website for details on what Snack consists of. Miss Cheryl will create a schedule at the beginning of each semester and email it to all parents, as well as post it on the White Rose Blog.

WhiteRose provides an organic, nutritious, whole food, hot lunch program.

**Acknowledgements:**

- I understand Cheryl reserves the right to five (consecutive or otherwise) emergency/illness days without tuition reduction, refund or additional days.
- Returning children: I understand that the Equipment & Materials Fees are due Feb 15th , and are non-refundable.
- Any parent or guardian picking up their child at or after 3:20 will be charged a late fee of \$1.00 per minute. The late fee will automatically be added to the following month's tuition to compensate for the inconvenience.
- I understand that my child's space in the program is not secured until all enrollment packet forms have been filled out and submitted.

From time to time, Cheryl takes photographs of the children at play, during meal times and other activities (as described in the Daily Rhythms section of the website). For ease of transition, before starting the Fall Program, it is advised that all new and returning children attend at least two weeks of a summer camp session.

Summer hours are **8:30-3:20, Monday - Friday**.

The dates for camp will be: **June 27th - Aug 19th** for a total of **8 weeks**.

Fees:	2 days/week	\$575/month (one time \$500.00 materials fee)
	3 days/week	\$800/month (one time \$525.00 materials fee)
	4 days/week	\$1050/month (one time \$550.00 material fee)
	5 days/week	\$1255/month (one time \$575.00 material fee)

First payment is due June 1st, remainder due July 1st. Materials fee due with contract. A \$50.00 interview fee will be deducted from the Materials fee upon receipt of a signed contract.

### **Understanding:**

When a family joins WhiteRose, I consider it to be a year-long commitment for us. I strive to meet the needs of your child and I truly invest my heart fully in them and your family. This work is my love and my passion. We at White Rose become like a family. A year commitment is asked for the stability of this “home away from home”. It is a wonderful experience for a young child to grow up first being the youngest, being cared for by the older children and adoring them for it, to becoming the older child caring for the youngest and being adored. This is a gift that will carry them through life.

Communication and exchange between home and school is essential. I hold a few Parent Nights throughout the year and I feel it is important for at least one parent to attend. I am also available by phone most evenings after 8:00pm.

The investment is more than personal. By entering into this contract, you represent that your child and you are committed for the entire school year. You do hereby acknowledge and agree that you are responsible for the full year's tuition. The Judgement of the school to forgive any tuition shall be final and within the sole discretion of the school. Unforeseen circumstances sometimes do arise (moving, loss of job...) and in that case I ask for a minimum of 2 months notice.

The undersigned, on behalf of themselves, their agents, successors and assigns, hereby absolve White Rose Preschool personnel of any liability, whether known or unknown, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of persons or entities mentioned above. The undersigned agrees to accept all responsibility for the risks, conditions and hazards, which may occur whether or not they are now known.

By signing this acknowledgment and assumption of risk and release as the parent or guardian, I am consenting to the child’s participation in White Rose program and related activities and acknowledge that I understand that all risk, whether known or unknown, is expressly assumed by me and all claims whether known or unknown, are expressly waived in advance.

This agreement shall be binding and effective upon the undersigned, their agents, successors and assigns.

I have read this full document and fully understand its terms and am willing to comply with White Rose’s policies and procedures as stated in this Contract Agreement. This agreement shall not be modified, nor shall any provision be waived except by written agreement signed by Cheryl Stegman, Owner, WhiteRose Preschool.
